ABOUT ASPIRE ACADEMY

Aspire Academy was founded in 2004 with the goal to find and develop the best young male Qatari athletes, whilst also providing them with high quality secondary school education. Since the population in Qatar is small the identification of talents at an early age is important and therefore we cooperate with schools and sports federations; we also have Multi-sport Skills Development Centers across Qatar to promote sports and prepare talented youths before they reach the appropriate age to be considered for the Academy.

In Football we conduct scouting in the clubs and schools as well as having our own Talent Centres, then Feeder Groups, that start working with the boys at a very early stage as well, but, of course, only the best young Qatari athletes and footballers receive scholarships to join Aspire.

In 2014, the results from our football program were promising including the fact that all players of the Qatari U-19 football national team that won the AFC-U19 Championship in Myanmar, and qualified for the 2015 FIFA U-20 World Cup in New Zealand, were past or current students of Aspire Academy.

It is, of course, one of the longer term goals of the Academy that some of our graduates will represent Qatar at the FIFA World Cup 2022.

In the Olympic and other sports, we are also achieving international success. Our graduate Mutaz Essa Barshim, a world class high jumper from Qatar, is the current World Champion and 2012 Olympic bronze medalist.

EDITORIAL: **A MAJOR ROLE** **IN OUR** **PLAYERS'** **DEVELOPMENT**

Since its establishment in 2012, the Tri-Series has played a major role in the development of the student-athletes of Aspire Academy. This tournament series is our system to compare, to benchmark and, most of all, to compete against the best youth teams in the world. It helps our players to develop a competitive mentality, because it's not just a series of friendlies, it's an actual competition, with results and points and a table. Do they have to win this game to ultimately win the whole tournament? Or would a



draw suffice? Mentally, they already have to be thinking forward to the next game.

Each season, the Tri-Series brings club teams, national youth teams and other academy teams to Doha. We selected the teams to participate according to precise criteria such as the standard of the youth development programme in the visiting nations, their profile and background. We not only want to compete against the strongest junior teams in the world, but also

against as many different styles and systems as possible. This format is about pushing and developing our players, which is why we only invite strong teams as opponents.

The competition has grown over the years and so have the people that are involved. The most important thing, however, is that our players identify with it. They have made it their championship and they are excited to play and are eager to know more about the teams they are competing against. For Aspire Academy this tournament series is also important in terms of making our philosophy known around the world. The visiting teams, on the other hand, not only have the chance to compete at a high level, but also to experience a different country with its unique culture.

During their time with us, all of the clubs are invited to present their work, philosophies and various topics related to working with junior players. This huge wealth of experience and international knowhow benefits not just our own coaches, but also the coaches of local teams in Qatar whom we invited. It's incredibly interesting and inspiring to hear about the diversity in the programmes in different countries and continents. For us, it's important that the visiting clubs want to share these things voluntarily, no one is forced to do it and we are happy that so many have accepted the opportunity so far.

In the fourth year we are looking to build on our progress of the previous years in every area. We hope once again to show that we are capable of hosting a tournament of this scale, and that our Aspire teams are capable of holding their own against the strongest of opponents. Even though the development of the individual players is our biggest priority, results are becoming increasingly important. It's a good sign because once our players realise they can mix it with the best, they also want to win. They won't always manage to, but it's still a big step forward in terms of their mindset.

THE SIX PILLARS OF SUCCESS



The individual development of players has a high priority.

Qatar's most talented players aged between 12 and 18, 30 coaches from fourteen different nations, utilizing seven outdoor football pitches and one indoor pitch, plus other sophisticated facilities such as a high-performance gym, sports halls and a Footbonaut: judging by the figures alone, Aspire Academy's football programme already sounds pretty impressive.

However, its real virtues run much deeper: the programme is based on a training philosophy tailored to the capabilities, talents and goals of Qatar as a footballing nation. Roberto Olabe, Football Director at Aspire Academy, explains the six fundamental pillars of this philosophy, the aim of which is to mould Qatari football stars from raw Qatari talent.

Sports Science also plays an important role in our philosophy.



1) FOCUSING ON THE PLAYER

Most academies tend to group their players into their own teams which compete in various championships, thereby developing their own player types in the context of their own systems. Aspire Academy takes a different approach: it places each of its students at the centre of a whole range of external teams – involving different systems and different demands. Olabe: "Our strategy is specifically geared towards the development of the individual player – towards his physical qualities, his technical-tactical and mental skills." Is football at the Aspire Academy seen as an individual rather than as a team sport? "No. But the success of a team is based on the quality of each of the players. That's why we focus on the strengths and weaknesses of every single player, so we can work on them individually. Most important is the development of game intelligence, a player's ability to understand every aspect of the game."

2) AGGRESSIVENESS THROUGH INTELLIGENCE

To be able to hold their own in their teams, Aspire Academy students need above all to possess one quality: game intelligence. Players need to be able to understand the game in order to understand their role and their responsibility in the game, irrespective of formation or scenario

– and to be able to apply their skills effectively. Olabe: "Our biggest task is to make sure our players understand the logic and structure of football in any given situation. In an individual sport, the repetition of individual movement and thought patterns can lead to success, but the same does not apply to team sports. Team sports are much more complex. Game intelligence is the key to unlocking individual skills." Additionally: "A good player is an aggressive player. Being aggressive means wanting to play an active role in the game. A player who reacts rather than acts probably doesn't understand the game."

3) ELITE MENTALITY

Technical and athletic skills at the highest level, unlocked by game intelligence – is this the blueprint for an outstanding player? No, not according to the Aspire Academy football philosophy. Olabe: "An elite player needs an elite mentality, a competitive character and a competitive attitude. He has to love competition, to love a challenge and he has to believe in his ability to rise to any challenge." Is that as tough as it sounds? "Yes and no. On the road to becoming a top athlete there are always times that are tough, times when you suffer. Also there are times that are superlatively beautiful, made even more beautiful when they are experienced as part of a team. Then there are

times when it's about having fun. We know that without fun, you cannot learn. Without fun, you cannot progress."

4) SPECIALISED COACHES

Aspire Academy scours the world for the most competent coaches it can find for its students – for one simple reason: coaches are the interface between the game and the players. Any player's development will be dependent on the quality of his coaches.

Olabe: "It is the goal and the responsibility of our coaches to make sure that the players learn what they have to learn. They also have to make sure students understand what they are learning and why they are learning it. So it's absolutely crucial for our coaches to possess superb communication skills. They also have to be able to motivate students, to get the very best out of them. This is especially important, because so-

metimes players aren't even aware of their full potential."

Aspire Academy coaches are specialised in the respective age group with which they are working. Olabe: "Each age group has its own challenges and priorities. A coach has to understand what's going on in the mind of a player of a particular age, what the next stage in his development should be." What makes a good junior coach? "He knows that his job is to help a player to develop and that his development is a work-in-progress. Just as there aren't any qualified architects or plumbers aged six, eight or twelve, there aren't any complete footballers aged six, eight or twelve. They have to be given the opportunity to be excellent footballers at the end of their development."

5) SCIENCE FOR PERFORMANCE

Not all of the parameters that make a successful footballer are measurable – but what can be

measured is measured, analysed and specifically developed at Aspire Academy by leading international experts using state-of-the-art methods: Football Performance and Science is the remit of Prof. Valter Di Salvo, an area for which he is also responsible within the Qatari National Team and the Qatar Stars League. For each player, bespoke plans and goals are defined in the physical, mental, technical and tactical arenas based on multiple parameters. Olabe: "It's all about assessing the effectiveness of the training to date, optimising future training and showing a player how far he has already come – and what's next."

6) NATIONAL INTEREST

Qatar is only a small nation, so naturally the talent pool is smaller compared with other countries; that's why it's even more important to really nurture individual athletes and leverage their full potential.

On an organisational level, this means that all of the key players in the footballing nation of Qatar have to pull together. There are already joint ideas and initiatives between Aspire, the QFA (Qatar Football Association) and the clubs of the QSL (Qatar Stars League). Olabe: "We have built up a collaborative network which enables our players, even after leaving the Academy, to compete at the highest level either in the QSL or with foreign clubs. We now need to maintain and further expand this network."

All eyes are on the 2022 World Cup, of course. "The players destined to represent Qatar in this tournament will come from this environment. Some of them are in a great position already – having also come to recognise the World Cup as a real opportunity for themselves and for their nation."

But 2022 must not be regarded as the final destination, it is merely the first big milestone in the roadmap for long-term development. "Even more important than the World Cup itself is what we are cultivating on our path to the World Cup – a new culture of competition, new methodologies, a new mentality. A winning mentality. The idea is for football in Qatar to benefit from the 2022 World Cup for many years to come."

TEAMWORK **MATTERS**

As part of its innovative tournament series, **35 leading clubs** and associations from all over the world visited Aspire Academy in the **2014-15 season** of the Tri-Series alone, encompassing **1,196 players** and **298 coaches**. The following pages provide a look behind the scenes of **39 tournaments** and **117 games** across nine age groups.

There is no denying the sporting benefits of this ambitious international project. But how much work goes into organizing and staging the tournament? Why are visitors from all over the world so impressed by Aspire Academy as host and organizer as well?

A COLLABORATIVE EFFORT WITHIN ASPIRE ACADEMY

The success of the Tri-Series can be seen as a lesson in solid teamwork within the Academy, as these insights reveal:

The planning for each upcoming season has generally already been completed by the end of April. The key to everything is the tournament schedule, which is first devised together with the Director of Football, Roberto Olabe, and which subsequently has to be coordinated according to the international and national commitments of the clubs and national teams

and also the academic year – a mammoth organizational task, which ultimately determines how the groups are put together.

The clubs are identified and invited according to the basic idea behind the tournament. „Ideally the respective groups of three teams will include clubs from two different continents alongside the Academy team,“ explains Stephan Hildebrandt, who as Head of Football Operations is responsible for the smooth running of the tournament. „Compared with last year, we have significantly increased the number of Asian clubs for the 2014-15 season because it's important for us to establish ourselves in Asia.“

It's because the Academy as an organization so fully embraces Aspire Academy's values, such as team-work and synergy, that it's operationally possible to deliver so many tournaments. With several departments involved in the Tri-Series, meticulous preparation goes into areas such as catering, transport, visas, flights, accommodation, interpreting, hiring of referees, medical care, PR and much more besides. „Everybody involved deserves a huge show of appreciation,“ stresses Hildebrandt, „because without them it just wouldn't be possible to stage a tournament of this scale.“

PARIS SAINT-GERMAIN, ATALANTA BERGAMO, CHELSEA, ETC.

Since its inception in the 2012-13 season, the format has also helped to establish the Academy as an elite venue for international competition; for instance, clubs of the caliber of Paris Saint-Germain and Atalanta Bergamo have already taken part twice in the Tri-Series tournament. With clubs like Chelsea also taking part for the very first time, it is clear that the top clubs are eager

to accept the invitation, because even they recognize the benefits of competing at such a high level in Doha.

„The Tri-Series,“ continues Hildebrandt, „has turned the Academy into a hub for international youth football and, as well as its sporting significance, the socio-cultural aspect should not be underestimated. For some young players this will be their first time on an airplane and their first exposure to Middle Eastern culture. We as hosts obviously want to do our bit to make sure their stay in Doha is an experience the teams will remember fondly for a very long time to come.“





make the transition from youth to adult football in the second Belgian division. My education has always remained a priority and I am glad about the great academic support when I was in Spain, Belgium or when I was with the national team. There are many things I will always remember from my time at Aspire. Teammates, coaches, teachers and a lot of other people that crossed my path during that time. There is one thing that stuck in my mind: If you want to get somewhere you have to give it your best. Never stop working hard and it will pay off some day.



A VERY VALUABLE EXPERIENCE



Tore André Flo (born 15 June 1973) is a retired Norwegian football striker. He was capped 76 times, scoring 23 goals for Norway and represented his country in the 1998 FIFA World Cup and UEFA Euro 2000. During his professional career he had a very successful spell with Chelsea FC (England) that included winning the 1998 UEFA Cup Winners' Cup, the 1998 UEFA Super Cup, the English FA Cup and League Cup, other teams he played for were Sunderland, Leeds United, Milton Keynes Dons (England), Glasgow Rangers (Scotland), Siena (Italy), Sogndal, Tromsø, Brann and Valerenga (Norway). In 2013 he returned to Chelsea as academy coach.

Tore André Flo: The former world-class striker and current youth coach at Chelsea FC talks about the Tri-Series, making the difficult step up to pro football and the even more difficult step of hanging up his boots.

THE TRI-SERIES GIVES ASPIRE ACADEMY TEAMS AN OPPORTUNITY TO BENCHMARK THEMSELVES AGAINST THE WORLD'S BEST YOUTH TEAMS ON A REGULAR BASIS. HOW IMPORTANT IS THIS KIND OF INTERNATIONAL EXPOSURE FOR YOUNG PLAYERS?

It's incredibly important. You at Aspire Academy, and we at Chelsea, share the same goal: to see how we measure up against the best teams in the world. English teams play very similar styles and systems, which makes any opportunity for our young players to benchmark themselves internationally all the more valuable. Tournaments like the Tri-Series, meetings with strong international teams such as those of Aspire Academy, provide a yardstick for our current form.

MAKING THE STEP UP TO PRO FOOTBALL ISN'T EASY, IS IT?

Of course, it's a tough world to break into and you need to work hard on yourself to get that break into first team football. I'm a good example of how important timing is. When I joined a bigger club aged 16, I wasn't ready for it. I was homesick, and I was back home again within a few months. It wasn't until I was 19 that I was ready to move away from my family. In 1996, aged 23, I had an offer from the Premier League. I decided against it at first, preferring to stay with Brann Bergen in Norway. It was only a year later that I joined Chelsea FC. Even though I was 24 at this point and already a Norwegian national team

player, I was still nervous at first. Joining such a big club was a big step after all. But mentally, I was ready. That was important.

YOU COME FROM A FOOTBALLING FAMILY; YOUR BROTHERS ALSO PLAYED PROFESSIONALLY. HOW MUCH RIVALRY WAS THERE BETWEEN YOU?

A lot! We all wanted to be the best, of course. I think I had an advantage, being the youngest. From being very small I was always up against older boys.

YOUR CAREER AS A PLAYER WAS IMPRESSIVE. WHAT LEFT THE BIGGEST IMPRESSION ON YOU?

I had a great time in England, my five kids were also born during that period. My family felt very much at home there, which was also the reason we moved back. Playing in Scotland for Glasgow Rangers was also a great experience and I always wanted to play in Italy, which I finally got to do in Siena. It's good to get to know different countries and styles of play.

IT MUST HAVE BEEN DIFFICULT TO FINALLY HANG UP YOUR BOOTS.

It was really tough, I missed the training and the matches a lot. I missed the competition – which might have been the reason I signed up to do the Norwegian version of the TV show Strictly Come Dancing. My body wasn't yet ready for retirement, which is why I made two comebacks – first in 2008 with MK Dons and then in 2011 with Sogndal back in my homeland. I had come full circle, because that's where I started my professional career almost 20 years before.



STEP BY STEP

Before Qatari players are old enough to join the football program of Aspire Academy as student-athletes at the age of 12, they may prove their potential in the Academy's feeder group teams. In the following interview, **Ed Graper**, coordinator of the Feeder Groups, talks about this important stage in the development of young players and the significance of being part of the Tri-Series.



Ed Graper and his team are in charge of the developing players before they are eligible to join the Academy.



WHAT IS THE GOAL OF THE FEEDER TEAMS FOR THE FOOTBALL PROGRAM OF ASPIRE ACADEMY?

On the one hand they offer the chance for us to spot talents that have the potential to join the Academy when they are at the right age. They allow us to teach them things that are normal in the life of a football player such as behaving in the dressing room, being a part of a team, taking responsibility on and off the pitch and, of course, we want them to develop the right attitude, so that they can become good players.

WHAT ROLE DOES THE TRI-SERIES PLAY IN THEIR DEVELOPMENT?

In season 2014-15 we have competed with the generations 2003, 2004 and 2005. Especially for the youngest age-group it was a big step, since it was the first time they were part of this tournament format. These games are important for many reasons: The boys take further steps in understanding the game by playing 7v7 on the half pitch and then 9v9 from box to box. They have the opportunity to face big clubs from Europe and they learn to deal with winning and losing.

HOW IMPORTANT ARE THE RESULTS AT THIS STAGE?

It's, of course, about gaining experience at this age and at times you can learn a lot from losing. But on the other hand we also compete to win and we are very happy about the progress of our teams. They might not have always succeeded, but you could see how players made the next steps in their development and there have also been some strong performances. The 2003 age group for instance had good results at the Tri-Series, but also at tournaments abroad where they won against Galatasaray, Panathinaikos and Werder Bremen in Turkey.

HOW IMPORTANT ARE GOOD RESULTS LIKE THAT?

They make the boys believe in themselves and as a result they will be more confident when they face other big names in the future. Of course, the older they get the harder they have to work to stay on top of their game. Hard work and determination are two requirements that are necessary if you want to get accepted as student-athlete at Aspire Academy.

WHAT DOES THE SELECTION PROCESS FOR THE FEEDER TEAMS LOOK LIKE?

Some players have already been part of our talent centers that are spread all over Qatar and which take in between 300 and 400 6-year-old boys each year. Others come from clubs or are referred to us by our Scouting Unit. Currently we have 20 players in each age group, however, if a boy wants to play in tournaments like the Tri-Series he has to show in training that he deserves it. There is always a huge competition for spots.

HOW COMPETITIVE IS IT THEN TO MAKE YOUR WAY FROM THE FEEDER TEAMS TO A FULL-TIME STUDENT AT ASPIRE?

While they are part of the feeder teams, the players are under constant assessment, they undergo tests with our sport science team and coaches constantly discuss their development. This is an on-going process and at the end of this evaluation the people in charge decide if a player has enough potential to join the Academy.

“CONTINUOUSLY FOCUS ON TECHNICAL DEVELOPMENT!”

WHAT WERE THE MAIN REASONS FOR CHOOSING ASPIRE ACADEMY AS THE LOCATION FOR YOUR TRAINING CAMP WITH ZENIT ST. PETERSBURG?

We chose Aspire again because of the structure and the conditions, because everything is easy to manage and very functional and we are very happy with the choice we made. The conditions are optimal, we can train on

amazing pitches, we have access to a fantastic gym and the hotel is also close by. You couldn't ask for more, and that's not easy to find this time of year.

YOU HAVE BEEN HERE BEFORE AND ARE FAMILIAR WITH ASPIRE ACADEMY'S PHILOSOPHY FOR DEVELOPING YOUNG PLAYERS. WHAT ARE YOUR THOUGHTS ON THIS?

Aspire Academy has been developing young players for a few years and we have seen the recent successes of the Qatari U19 national team. These results have been very important, because it shows that a clear vision has been defined and that people at Aspire are committed to this vision. Hopefully this can be transferred to 2022, when the World Cup comes here. I think that all the steps taken so far have been the right ones, there has been consistent development and I think Aspire Academy sets a really good example for others.

WHAT'S THE MOST IMPORTANT ASPECT OF WORKING WITH YOUNG PLAYERS?

With young players, you have to continuously focus on technical development. The tactical side can be addressed later.

THE TRANSITION FROM YOUTH TO ADULT FOOTBALL IS OFTEN THE HARDEST STEP. WHAT QUALITIES DOES A YOUNG PLAYER NEED TO SUCCEED AT ADULT LEVEL?

As a young player, you might think that playing is more important than being in an environment with the best players, where your chances to play are limited. But I disagree a little with this conception, because a young player has to be able to survive and succeed in the most difficult environment. A young player needs resilience and persistence, because he might not immediately get the chance to play. He also has to believe in his skills and have confidence.
